Here we go...

A staggering 30% of women have *never* had an orgasm.

The second group of is where the majority of women sit. Depending on the statistics we look at, it is safe to say that between to 50% and 70% of women have only ever had clitoral orgasms.

Finally, we get to the group of very lucky women who have experienced vaginal orgasms. Again, different statistics tell slightly different stories, but whatever the exact case – one thing is for sure... the percentage of women who have experienced vaginal orgasms is pretty low (somewhere between 10% and 30%).

Be aware that many of those women who have had vaginal orgasms do not necessarily have them regularly.

Said differently, only a tiny percentage of women have vaginal orgasms on a regular basis.

At this point I'll also point out that vaginal orgasms lay the foundation for squirting and multiple orgasms and to some extent – anal orgasms too.

So if you want to be a truly great lover, a guy who is capable of giving his woman THE BEST SEX EVER – you really have to give your woman vaginal orgasms because when you do... a whole new world of sexuality will open up for you and her to share.

Now that you know how few women are receiving regular, incredible sexual pleasure from their men, let's take a look at...

“Why Most Average Guys Are Lame In Bed”

You may think it is harsh of me to say that most average guys are *lame* in bed.

Perhaps I could have been more politically correct about it and said that most average guys are 'okay' in bed or most average guys just 'need a little help'.

But I'm not in the business of B.S.

On the contrary, I only deal in the truth and if I offend a few people along the way – I'm cool with that because I know that I'll help tons of people in the process too.

So I stand by what I said – the average man is LAME IN BED.

I mean, think about it – women are capable of **vaginal, squirting, multiple and anal orgasms** and yet most men are only giving their women clitoral orgasms and quite a lot of men are not getting their women off in any way at all.

I'd say that's pretty lame.

Wouldn't you *agree*?

You know, sex is a really weird thing because virtually every man wants it and wants to be good at it, but very few have the common sense to seek help when they need it.

Somewhat of a contradiction, don't you think?

I mean, if you or I wanted to be good at Golf or Tennis, Football or Boxing, Basketball or Chess – we'd probably hire a good coach to teach us his knowledge and help us along the way.

Same with Business – if we wanted to set up a successful business, we'd seek out the advice of people who've 'been there and done it'... people who have already produced the kinds of results we'd like to experience in a given area of our lives.

However, when it comes to sex – most guys are too embarrassed or have too much of an ego to seek out advice and that's why they are lame in bed.

Think about it – how many people ever become outstanding at something (or even moderately good) without some help from someone who's already produced excellent results in the area they wish to excel at?

Not many is the correct answer to that question.

The next thing I'm going to talk to you about is Sex Toys and more specifically...

Why Most Sex Toys Absolutely Suck

When I say that most sex toys absolutely suck, I am referring to dildos and vibrators.

(There are some sex toys, like The Remote Control Egg – which can be incredibly good fun).

For clarification, a Dildo is a penis shaped sex toy and a vibrator is a penis shaped sex toy that vibrates.

DUH!

Yeah, I know, pretty obvious – but I just wanted to check that we were on the same page before I move on.

So here's the deal...

Some men think it's a good idea to buy a dildo or vibrator to help 'get their women off'.

However, this is in fact a *really* bad idea.

Here's why...

The average guy is either not giving his woman orgasms or he's only giving her clitoral orgasms, but the fact is that all women crave vaginal orgasms (even if they don't say so).

So the average man brings home a dildo or vibrator (which is usually much bigger than his own 'little chap') and he uses it to pleasure his woman. Now the reality is that the sex toy probably *won't* give his woman vaginal orgasms, but if it does – that's bad news.

Now you might be thinking:

“Hold on Adam, you just said vaginal orgasms were a good thing”

Yes I did, but can you imagine what the average man’s woman thinks when he’s never given her a vaginal orgasm and then all of a sudden he does it for the first time using a dildo or vibrator?

A dildo or vibrator much bigger than his own ‘little chap’.

Ouch.

That’s right – his woman now thinks it’s a *size* issue.

Then she starts to associate *more* ‘size’ with an increase in her sexual pleasure.

And do you think she’ll be forever happy with her man and his collection of sex toys?

Nope, she’ll want the real thing.

In other words – she’ll start fantasizing about a man giving her vaginal orgasms while he is having intercourse with her. A man with a much bigger penis than her current man has.

Then she might CHEAT on him or totally leave him for a man with a bigger ‘tool’.

Did you know that 50% of women admit to having cheated at least once in their lives and the biggest reason for cheating was to GET BETTER SEX?

If that’s not a really hard kick in the nuts for any man, then I don’t know what is.

But anyway, what’s the *truth*?

Does ‘size’ *really* matter?

The short answer is:

No it doesn’t, and you’ll see why I say that as you progress through this program and then try out the orgasm techniques for yourself.

But if you go about things the wrong way, like our average guy did in the previous example – it is possible to condition your woman to think that size matters.

I must just state that it is unlikely that a big sex toy is going to give a woman her first vaginal orgasm. But that doesn't mean that 'average guy' with his sex toy is out of trouble just yet.

You see, if he doesn't give his woman vaginal orgasms during intercourse – she's not really fulfilled by it. I don't care what a woman might say (in order to protect her man's feelings); she's not fulfilled unless she comes during intercourse.

But, if 'average man' uses that big, thick sex toy to pleasure his woman – he might end up giving her more 'feeling downstairs' than she is used to when he has intercourse with her.

So even though the sex toy doesn't 'get her off', it does make the penetration more pleasurable.

What you can clearly see is that these kinds of sex toys (dildos and vibrators), are rarely a good thing.

With that said, once you are regularly giving your woman vaginal orgasms during intercourse (and you are going to find out how to do this regardless of your 'size') – you can then use whatever sex toy you want because your woman will be SEXUALLY ADDICTED to you. Guaranteed.

That's the power of vaginal orgasms during intercourse.
